Introduction:

The Regional Institute of Paramedical & Nursing Sciences (RIPANS) was established during 1994-95 under North Eastern Council (NEC) as an Autonomous body with due approval of the concerned Ministries of Government of India to cater the much needed Paramedical, Nursing and Pharmacy personnel of the North Eastern States viz, Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Tripura and Sikkim. The Institute is situated at the outskirt of Aizawl, Mizoram in a secluded hilly slope of about 39.60 bighas. The Institute was transferred to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India from NEC w.e.f 1st April, 2007.

ADMINISTRATIVE SET UP OF RIPANS

The Director of the Institute is the administrative and executive head of the Institute under whom the Administrative Set up of the Institute can be broadly divided into two wings –

- (a) Administration & Establishment Wing
- (b) The Academic Wing.

(A) ADMINISTRATION & ESTABLISHMENT WING

In the Administrative & Establishment set up, there are two sections viz. Establishment and Account. In Establishment Section there is an Administrative Officer who is responsible to ensure smooth running of day to day functions of the administration and establishment while Account Section is headed by Finance & Accounts Officer who is responsible for preparation of Five Year Plan and Annual Plan of the Institute taking into consideration the requirements of the whole Institute. The FAO is also responsible for maintaining the financial discipline of the budgetary allocation of the Institute. Both the Administrative & Accounts Officers are responsible to offer free and frank advice to the Director of the Institute who is the overall in-charge of the Institute for management and administration.

(B) ACADEMIC WING

To ensure smooth functioning of the different courses offered by the Institute, for each department there are Heads of Departments assisted by Asst. Professors, Demonstrators, Lab. Assistants & Lab. Technicians and other subordinate staff. The Head of Department is accountable for the activities of the department in terms of the course conducted and of the students. The Director is informed of the activities of the department and any problem which arises in the course of functioning. The Head of Department is entrusted to ensure completion of the training course and conduct of annual and final examinations in consultation with Mizoram University and Mizoram State Council for Technical Education (MSCTE).

Hence, the Institute is purchasing water from private sources for which we are spending Rs. 1.5 lakhs (approx.) per month in the year 2013-2014.

TRAINING & PLACEMENT SECTION

Dr.Nivedita Sharma M.D (Obs.& Gynae), P.G.D.H.H.M, P.G.D.M.L.S Officer-in-charge, Training & Placement, Co-ordinator (Examinations, IQAC)

The Training & Placement Section of RIPANS is mainly the Coordinating body of the Institute for the various courses conducted at RIPANS namely, the Technical Degree Courses of B.Sc (Nursing), B.Pharmacy, B.Sc-MLT, Bachelor's Degree in Optometry and Ophthalmic Techniques(B.Sc-O.O.T) and Bachelor's Degree in Radiography & Imaging Technology (B.Sc-R.I.T).

RIPANS is a centre for academic excellence in Paramedical & Nursing Sciences for students from the 8 North Eastern States who want to pursue a career in these technical disciplines. The State Government of the 8 states have their own selection criteria on the basis of merit by which students are nominated for the respective courses of RIPANS. The intake capacity every year for the Degree Courses is 33, excluding Pharmacy which is 30. Vacant seats will be filled up from waiting lists from the 8 state governments.

Mizoram University which is a Central University by Parliament Act No.8 of 2000 has granted Permanent Affiliation to RIPANS as an Institute vide letter No.MZU/CDC/1/10/09/376 dated 30.7.2009 vide its resolution No.E.C.:22:5 (11) in its Executive Council held on 30.6.2009. Permanent Affiliation to B.Sc (Nursing), B.Pharmacy & B.Sc-MLT courses has been granted by Mizoram University to RIPANS vide letter No.MZU/CDC/1/10/11/752 dated 27.7.2011 and Provisional Affiliation to Bachelor's Degree in Radiography and Imaging Technology (BRIT) and Bachelor's Degree in Optometry and Ophthalmic Techniques has been granted vide letter No.MZU/CDC/1/10/11/747 dated 19.7.2011. The period of 3 years has been completed and renewal of provisional affiliation has been applied for further 3 years for these two courses. The B.Sc (N) Course is conducted in accordance with Indian Nursing Council (INC) Guidelines and Syllabus and is in conformity with INC directives which are the regulatory and statutory body. The B.Pharmacy course is conducted in conformity with the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) which are the regulatory and statutory bodies. The syllabus followed is as per PCI prescribed syllabus and stipulations. B.Sc.-MLT, B.Sc-OOT and B.Sc-RIT courses are also conducted in conformity with Mizoram University and National Task Force of D.G.H.S. which are regulatory and statutory bodies.

In 2014 Academic Session Pharmacy Department is initiating M.Pharmacy course with a maximum intake of 32 students per year in the 4 subjects viz. Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmacognosy, Pharmacology.

The Compliance Report & Mandatory Disclosures to the AICTE are sent each year for the B.Pharmacy Course. SIF (Standard Information Format) for the year 2013 has been duly submitted to Pharmacy Council of India. Extension of Approval by AICTE to RIPANS for 2013-2014 was accorded vide letter No.F.No.Eastern/1-1382511065/2013/EOA dt 19.3.2013 and PCI letter No.17-1/2012-PCI/43064-483 dated 23.5.2012 for 2013-2014.

Exposure and Study Tours to other esteemed hospitals and medical institutions were organized to Guwahati and Hyderabad.

This year the Graduation and Lamp Lighting of passing out batch and freshly inducted batch of Nursing students was held on 22nd November, 2013. Convocation for all Degree and Diploma courses was held on the same day at the new open-air stage within RIPANS Campus. It was a graceful occasion, full of bonhomie and camaraderie in a kaleidoscope of vibrant colours. Fresher's Welcome was held on 15th November, 2013 and Parafest the Sports & Cultural Bonanza from 8th -15th November, 2013.

Following are the duties and responsibilities of Training & Placement section.

- (1) All matters related to payment of Affiliation fees to Mizoram University, PCI, INC, AICTE & MNC.
- (2) All matters pertaining to Admissions of students and information to the 8 constituent states namely Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Tripura, Manipur, Sikkim, Nagaland, Meghalaya & Mizoram.
- (3) All matters pertaining to Stipend of Students, their Identity Cards, etc.
- (4) All matters pertaining to Inspection by various councils i.e. INC, PCI, AICTE and MSCTE and payment of Inspection fee.
- (5) Matters related to Examinations and correspondence relevant for Examinations.
- (6) The placement records of passed out students and ex-alumni of RIPANS is also maintained as far as practicable by the section.

- (7) This section also serves as the Examination Cell for RIPANS to co-ordinate and organize in the conducting of Mizoram University Examinations. Results are also disseminated after receiving the results from the University.
- (8) This section serves as the Internal Quality Assurance Cell vide Order No.F.13018/1/11-RIPANS/ 7 dated 27.5.2011. The Training & Placement Section thus functions as an amalgamating and coordinating body to synchronize the academic matters of the various courses conducted by the institute and converges the correspondence both incoming and outgoing of the various departments into a single channel thereby avoiding correspondence individually or department wise that may create confusions. It thus serves to streamline the academic activities of the institute and ensures uniformity. Initiation and starting of new courses and up-gradation of existing courses is also done by this section.
- (9) Comprehensive Detailed Project Report for 9th R.I.P.S and 100 Bedded Hospital has been entrusted to H.L.L Ltd. Relevant Documents for Comprehensive D.P.R for 9th RIPS vide -

The Training & Placement & Examination Cell is situated in the Administrative Block in the Directorate Office and is directly under the Director, RIPANS. The main aim and objective is to facilitate and ensure uniformity and stream lining and smooth functioning of all academic activities of the Institute.

Under the aegis of Director General of Health Services 1 NIPS & 9 RIPS are being established for standardizing Para Medical Education in India. The National Task Force for formation of Para Medical educational norms has included RIPANS. The syllabus followed at RIPANS will be the same as at NIPS & RIPS. However, in addition to Para Medical courses at NIPS & RIPS, RIPANS also has Nursing and Pharmacy which are regulated by Indian Nursing Council and Pharmacy Council of India. The National Task Force met on 19.6.2009 at NIHFW to finally decide the course curriculum for all paramedical courses.

The U.G.C had granted Recognition under 2(f) & 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956 vide letter F.No.8-170/2010(CPP-I/C) dt 21.8.2013. This is subsequent to Permanent Affiliation of RIPANS as an Institute to Mizoram University which was

granted on 30th July, 2009. This is different from separate Permanent Affiliation of each of the respective Degree Courses which is achieved for 3 of our courses.

Presently there are 5 Degree Technical courses conducted by the Institute.




Fig. Pie-Chart showing department-wise strength of students.

Brief Introduction

The Bachelor of Science (Nursing) Degree programme was first introduced at the Institute in the year 1996 to become the first nursing college in the state of Mizoram, and second in the North Eastern Region (NER). The course prepares the students to contribute to the development of nursing science through clinical and theory classes, which is based on scientific principles.

During the course of B.Sc(Nursing), students are exposed to a variety of teaching methods, all of which are designed to meet the requirement of Indian Nursing Council (INC) and to ensure that the students acquire a sound knowledge and skills in nursing.

About the Programme

The B.Sc(Nursing) programme is a four years programme and the students have to appear for an examination at the end of each year up to 4th year. They are expected to have clinical experience both in hospitals and community settings. The main activities are as follows:-

- 1. **Lectures:** These are designed to provide the student with the fundamental subjects. Each class is held in the afternoon after clinical exposure in hospitals. Students are strictly expected to attend the class and must have 75% attendance in all the theory subjects.
- 2. Clinical and Community Health Experience: This provides the student with an opportunity to apply her or his knowledge and develop appropriate practical skills in patients care as well as community setting. They are divided into 4 or 5 numbers of students and practice nursing skills under supervision of Clinical Instructors. During clinical experience the students are expected to undertake case study, case presentation on selected patients and give nursing care to the patients under the guidance of nursing teachers. This help to develop skills and offer a platform for the students to participate fully in the learning process. The students must have 100% attendance in practical to be able to appear in the university examination. time missed from clinical experience must be made up after completion of each year.

Introduction:

The Bachelor level course- BScRIT replaced the previous Diploma level programme. The first batch joined in September 2011. This course is designed to train the students in handling of various sophisticated Radiology equipments. Radiodiagnosis is one of the major component of modern health care and on completion of the programme the students are expected to be able to handle the various equipments in Radiodiagnosis and thus contribute in the process of providing proper health care to the population. In recent times the use of machines such as X-Ray, Ultrasound, CT Scan and MRI has significantly increased and also a relatively new field of Interventional Radiology has also seen significant growth. Students in this course are trained to be able to use these equipments and support the Doctors in getting the best out of these equipments and contribute towards proper diagnosis, proper treatment and overall patient care.

On completion of the course the students have a variety of career options which include working in various hospitals / clinics – both in Government and Non-Government organizations. They can also join training institutes as Demonstrators. They can also pursue higher studies in the form of MScRIT and then on to PhD etc where they can then join teaching centres as Lecturers and pursue a teaching / academic career.

Facilities received during the period:

Equipments for Physics laboratory and anatomical models for demonstration purpose were received during the year. New class room was provided for final year students New computer, projector and teaching accessories were added.

- c) Practical exposure to students were provided in the form of field visits to Mizoram State Cancer Institute, Civil Hospital, Aizawl and Trinity Diagnostic Centre, Aizawl

Details of inspections carried out by Technical Council, etc. during the period:

Prof R K Thapa, Chairman BUGS BScRIT and Dean School of Physical Sciences, Mizoram University visited the institute.

Other achievement:

- a) The Department has admitted the 3rd batch in 2013. The first batch of students are scheduled to appear in their final semester examinations in 2014.
- b) New teaching systems were introduced including student seminars and use of audio-visual aid.
- c) Classes for the 2nd semester students in Basic Nursing care, Hospital management, organization structure etc besides their regular curriculum were conducted and well received.

Future Plan

The new batch is expected to join in September 2014. As of now the Department is concerned with basic things like completion of syllabi in time and efficient conduct of exams etc. Once adequately staffed and basic issues like availability of class rooms etc are catered to , the Department plans to enhance its activities. Some of the important activities on the anvil include:

- Field trip to medical college
- Seminars and workshops to be conducted by faculty from other places who can guide them on issues like career prospects and areas of focus.
- Practical experience is important and the third year students will be posted in various hospitals.
- Department wishes to acquire couple of new equipments like Ultrasound machine and mammography machine so that the students can be trained to handle them.
- The major hurdle the Department faces at present is lack of qualified manpower and we hope that once this issue is taken care of, a number of initiatives can be planned out for the benefit of students so that they can be trained to become qualified technologists as also responsible members of the society.

Computer Centre of RIPANS is located at Academic-I building having an attached Computer Laboratory with 35 nos. of seating capacity. RIPANS Institute's Computer Centre is well equipped with IT Digital presentation instruments and high speed Internet connection. BRIEF REPORT on CTI-RIPANS CELL

H. Zorempuia Consultant (Fin.) CTI-RIPANS Cell

Genesis:

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), Govt. of India identified National Institute of Health and Family Welfare (NIHFW) as National Nodal Agency for coordinating the training under RCH in December 1997. NIHFW carried out the assigned task of development of prototype modules, training curricula & other training materials, coordinating training, conducting training of Master Trainers and monitoring the training in various parts of the country during RCH I. NIHFW was assisted in this task by 18 Collaborating Training Institutions (CTIs).

Subsequently in April 2006 after initiation of NRHM and RCH II, NIHFW was identified as National Nodal Agency for coordinating training under NRHM (both RCH and Disease Control) and was also entrusted with the responsibility of evolving a training strategy for integration of training for each category of personnel under various vertical programmes.

In December 2007, NIHFW was also given the additional responsibility of monitoring performance for certain aspects of RCH programme in the country especially high focus states. NIHFW would be assisted by 20 CTIs for carrying out the tasks of coordination training and monitoring performance.

The MoHFW (Training Division), Govt. of India approved the involvement of four new CTIs vide its letter no. A-11033/28/11-Trg dated 25.10.2011 among which the Regional Institute of Paramedical and Nursing Sciences (RIPANS) was also included for the monitoring of RCH-II/NRHM training through the NIHFW.

Accordingly, the Memorandum of Understanding was signed between Director, RIPANS, Mizoram and Director, NIHFW, New Delhi on 27th October, 2011. The CTI-RIPANS will be responsible for the following task for each financial year:

- 1) Situation analysis of all the training institutions of the districts in the state and below and develop a common annual training plan for the states in consultation with all such training institutions and NIHFW.
- 2) To provide guidance to the districts in preparation of district training plans.

- 3) Compile and update database of training institutes and trainers on a regular basis, through training monitoring software developed by NIHFW. Also make this information available through GIS.
- 4) Ensure availability of learning materials and modernization of Library facilities for capacity development of trainers through regular updates of knowledge and training skills.
- 5) Compilation and review of all training materials available in the state in local languages for various kinds of trainings.
- 6) Development of an induction package for the state in consultation with NIHFW. And to get it implemented with help from other institutions, both government and non-government.
- 7) Coordination of all training activities. Assist districts and below in facilitation of synchronous training. Also develop CTPs in consultation with the districts and finally in consultation with NIHFW.
- 8) To procure the training materials from NIHFW, translate, adapt and print copies.
- 9) To distribute the training materials to all selected training instructions.
- 10) To conduct training of trainers of the selected institutions and other training course in the region in accordance with the approval plans.
- 11) Development of linkages with Medical Colleges and other training institutions for conducting of training activities.
- 12) To evaluate training carried out as per the training instructions in the defined region including on site visits of the institutions, provide evaluation reports to the state authorities and NIHFW and take corrective measures.
- 13) Monitoring and evaluation of impact-keeping track of the linkages between training institutions, trainers and trainees.
- 14) To submit to Director, NIHFW monthly Statement of Expenditure (SOE) by 20th of every month and Audited Annual Accounts and Utilization Certificate by 30th June every year.

Monitoring of Trainings

Mizoram and Meghalaya had been assigned to CTI-RIPANS and hence, the Consultants except Consultant (Fin.) are being sent to monitor the trainings under RCH-II/NRHM wherever the trainings took place and submitted their reports to NIHFW, New Delhi before 25th of every month for compilation and onward submission to the Hon'ble Prime Minister office.
